



## ***Photo Tips***

### ***Photo Composition***

Pay attention to how you frame the subjects in your photos to create interesting perspectives. One of the most important rules in photography is the Rule-of-Thirds. It's difficult for most of us to not just pick up the camera and start snapping shots. The Rule-of-Thirds suggests dividing each photo frame into 9 sections, like a tic-tac-toe board. The points of interest in the frame should align with any of the four points of intersection.



When using the Rule-of-Thirds you must keep in mind that most cameras focus in the center of frame and if your subject is skewed to the left or right you might not be in focus. By using your camera's exposure lock you can ensure the proper focus. Position the subject in the center of the photo, and then depress the shutter button half-way to lock the exposure. Now, recompose the picture by moving the subject to one of the intersection points on the tic-tac-toe and fully depress the shutter button.
