



- ❖ An increase or decrease in Shutter Speed by one setting, doubles or halves the exposure. Twice as much light at 1/30s as at 1/60s.
- ❖ Use a tripod if shutter speed is slower than 1/30s or if using a zoom lens and speed is the inverse of focal length.
- ❖ The greater distance from a subject results in greater depth of field regardless of f-stop.
- ❖ Large f-stops enlarge the range of focus and small f-stops shrink the range of focus to cause background blur.
- ❖ ISO above 200 causes digital noise.
- ❖ Aperture-Priority Mode allows you to set the f-stop with auto shutter speed while Shutter-Priority Tv allows setting of shutter speed and auto f-stop.
